

FREE Tickets to Six Flags

Welcome to another year of the Read to Succeed Six Flags reading program. This program is for ALL students enrolled in Pathways Charter School in grades K-6. (Please no siblings not enrolled with Pathways and no students older than 6th grade!)

All you have to do is read for pleasure for 6 hours and you will receive a free ticket to Six Flags theme parks. Follow the steps below to participate:

1. Be enrolled in Pathways Charter School in grades K-6.
2. Download the reading forms for student and for teacher.
3. Read for pleasure (comic books, newspaper, chapter books, etc) for a total of six hours - keep track on student form.
4. Parents sign student verifying 6 hours.
5. Parents fill out a teacher form for their child, and you can ALSO receive a free ticket. List your name as teacher and your child/children as student.
6. Turn in both forms - SIGNED- to reading coordinator by Feb 24, 2010.
7. Wait for free ticket to arrive in May.
8. Enjoy a free day at Six Flags between June` 14 thru Aug 8, 2010.

Get Wild About Reading with the 2009-2010 Six Flags Six Hour Reading Club®!

Dear Families,

Your child's school is participating in an exciting program that encourages children in grades K through 6 to read for fun. The Six Flags Six Hour Reading Club is part of Read to Succeed®, a free language arts program from Six Flags and Weekly Reader. Every student who completes six hours of recreational reading before the school's deadline noted below is eligible for a free admission ticket valid at participating Six Flags theme parks. (Note: Schools must submit their information to us by March 3, 2010.) We hope that you have fun encouraging your child to get wild about reading and reach this goal!

Here's what you need to know:

- Only students in grades K through 6 are eligible to take part in the Reading Club.
- Review the reading log that your child brought home. Your child should use this sheet to record what and how long he/she reads.
- Your child must complete six hours, or 360 minutes of recreational reading. Please initial each entry and then sign the reading log to show that the six hours of reading has been completed.
- Your child can read books, magazines, newspapers, or comic books. What doesn't count is any reading your child must do for homework or a class assignment. Kids can read silently, aloud, or with an adult—you can read to your child, or your child can read to you.
- Remind your child to return the reading log to his/her teacher by the date on the form. Late entries will not be accepted.



About the tickets:

Tickets will be distributed to students by the school's Reading Club coordinator. The ticket is valid for admission from June 14 through August 8, 2010 only. (Note: Valid dates for The Great Escape ONLY: June 28 through August 15, 2010.) Lost, stolen, or damaged tickets cannot be replaced.

Look for the Family Discount Offer! Each Read to Succeed ticket will come with a discounted admission ticket offer for families so that they can celebrate their child's accomplishment. This discount information will be printed on the student ticket and can be accessed at sixflags.com/rts.

Thank you for participating in the Six Flags Six Hour Reading Club! This year, your school can prepare and submit the Reading Club forms online. If your coordinator has not set up an account and the school is not using the online system this year, please complete this sheet following these steps:



- Write the names and grades of all your students (K through 6 only) who submitted completed and signed reading logs. Enter each student's name once. Use a second sheet if necessary.
- Use K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 to indicate the student's grade. No other codes will be accepted.
- List one teacher's name on this form. Each qualifying teacher must complete his/her own sheet in order to receive one free admission ticket valid at participating Six Flags theme parks. Only one ticket will be awarded per teacher even if he/she submits more than one list.
- Fill in this form completely and accurately and sign it.
- Make copies of this list and your students' reading logs for your files.
- Submit this list along with your students' forms to your Reading Club coordinator by the date shown below. On or before **March 3, 2010**, your school's coordinator will submit one ticket request for all the participants in the school.
- Do not mail your list independently. Forms will be accepted **only** from coordinators in schools signed-up for the Read to Succeed program. Neither teachers nor coordinators may send in additional class lists or names of students once the original mailing has been submitted.
- Tickets will be sent to the coordinator's attention in late April.

Tickets cannot be replaced if lost, stolen, or damaged.
